





The proposed design modifications potentially affecting the park are:

- Addition of a looped ramp in the area of the Crosstown/IH 37 interchange
- Addition of approximately 0.99 acre of additional right-of-way from T.C. Ayers Park



Approved Impacts to T.C. Ayers Park










Proposed Impacts to T.C. Ayers Park
