

Construction on south tower of Cable Stay Bridge making tons of progress

Crews on the Cable Stay Bridge (CSB) portion of the project are turning some heads with the amount of progress that is being made on the south tower. If you drive by Whataburger Field, you can't help but notice two of the very large columns that are coming up out of the ground. These large columns are actually the lower legs to the CSB south tower. So far, the CSB crews have completed a total five 18 feet lifts on the west leg and five 18 feet lifts on the east leg. Both of the legs currently stand 90 feet tall. Crews continue to work around the clock to build platforms, modify form panels and install the necessary components for each lift. Once complete, both the south and the north towers will stand 538 feet tall, which will make the new Harbor Bridge the tallest structure south of San Antonio.



March Sidewalk Talk huge success

It was a beautiful day on March 30th as close to 100 people attended the March Sidewalk Talk event held at the Robstown Pre Cast Yard. The free event, open to the community, allows attendees the opportunity to learn more about the specific processes related to the construction of the 100-ton bridge segments.
